

Goals

Highlight certain movies and stories / genres / companies

Groupings

Group 1: Trends over time, groupings by if movie passes or not, highlighted movies

Group 2: Trends, groupings by pass/not, groupings by genre

Group 3: Trends, grouping by pass/not, groupings by genre, overall list of inputs




Organizations of the data: Trends, grouping by pass/not, groupings by genre (could be difficult, so I might need to have a third section that only focuses on a specific company or director)




Percent of movies that passed the bechdel test since the test was created in 1985

While there is an upward trend, 30% of movies last year did not pass the test.


This test only requires that two named women speak to each other about something other than a man.


Give that low bar, movies still have a long way to go in closing this gender gap.


Next Iterations:

Goal 1: emphasize the upward trend (+ still having a long way to go)

As of now, the trend is not clear becasue, mainly, there is no scale on either axis. Could also emphasize this additionally in other ways

Goal 2: add which criteria each movie does pass when hovered over

Users cannot immediately see which criteria a single movies does indeed pass without clicking the next criteria and searching for it again. Additionally, will want to implement ability to click on a specific movie and follow its movements
